

SAFE HAVEN

A "Safe Haven" Baby Box was installed recently in Paducah.

Location: Fire Station #5, 1714 Broadway Street, Paducah, KY 42001

Purpose: A Safe Haven Baby Box is a designated location where parents can anonymously and safely leave an infant they are unable or unwilling to care for.

The process involves opening the box's secure door, placing the baby inside, and then closing the door. Once the door is shut, a sensor alerts authorities to retrieve the baby. These boxes aim to prevent unsafe abandonmentand ensure that infants are placed in proper care, following legal protocols.
