MONTH OF NOVEMBER DECICATED TO THE HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY

Today on All Souls Day and the whole month of November the Church encourages us to intensify our prayers for the Souls in Purgatory. Our prayers, sacrifices and gaining of indulgences are ways that we in charity can help those still in the state of purification, who are awaiting entrance into the Beatific Vision (heaven). Remember those of our parish who have died in the past year especially. Remember any of your friends or neighbors that have died in the past year too.

- November 1st-November 8th: The faithful can obtain a plenary indulgence for the faithful departed "every day, from the 1st to the 8th of November," if, in addition to <u>fulfilling the normal terms of a plenary indulgence</u> (if you forgot the normal terms of gaining a plenary indulgence see paper on table in the back of church), one "devoutly visit[s] a cemetery and at least mentally pray[s] for the dead."
- On November 2nd, All Souls Day: The faithful who devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite an Our Father and the Creed can gain a plenary indulgence for a Soul in Purgatory provided they fulfill the normal terms of gaining a plenary indulgence.


