A SHORT HISTORY OF VETERANS DAY

Veterans Day was originally called Armistice Day in the United States, commemorating the signing of the agreement that ended World War I at 11:00 am, November 11, 1918. President Woodrow Wilson celebrated the first Armistice Day in 1919. In 1938, November 11th became a legal holiday by an act of Congress. In 1954, this federal holiday was changed from "Armistice" to "Veterans" Day.

Although this holiday initially honored those who perished in service to their country, when the holiday's name was changed to Veterans Day, it became a day to honor all the men and women who have served in the armed forces of the United States. Each year, special ceremonies are held at Arlington National Cemetery in Virginia.

What Does Veterans Day Mean? Veterans Day is an important day set aside to honor and show appreciation for ALL who have served in the United States military—in wartime or peacetime, living or deceased.


